AUCTION NOTICE

Auction will be held under the supervision of the Managing Director, Nellore Co-operative Spinning Mills Ltd., Nellore on 25-11-68 at 9-00 a.m. on-wards on the list of materials taken possession by the Mills from the Contractors, M/s. B. Subba Reddy & B. Chandra Reddy, Nellore-2.

Materials are available for inspection at the premises of the Spinning Mills, Opp: Industrial Estate, Nellore.

The following conditions of sale are laid down for the information of the intending bidders.

1. Any person or body intending to bid must deposit a sum of Rs. 150/- as Earnest Money with the Selling Officer and obtain a receipt, before taking part in the auction.

2. No one will be allowed to bid for another person unless he holds a power of attorney from him and produces the same for the inspection of Selling Officer when demanded by him.

3. The sale will ordinarily be knocked by the highest bidder but the right is reserved to the Officer conducting the sale to reject any bid without assigning any reason therefor.

4. Earnest Money deposited by unsuccessful bidders will be refunded to them at the close of the sale and that of successful bidder will be adjusted towards further payment as laid down in clause 8 below.

5. The sale will not be considered as completed unless it is confirmed by the Sub-Committee of the Board of Directors of the Mills constituted to consider the urgent problems facing the administration of the Mills who reserve the right to refuse or to confirm the sale without assigning any reasons therefor.

6. The aforesaid materials are offered for sale "as is, where is" condition.

7. The provisionally successfull bidders should deposit no sooner the bid is knocked down 25% (one fourth) of the bid amount. The balance of the bid amount shall be paid and the materials removed within Ten days of confirmation of the sale by the Sub-committee.

8. Should the sale not be approved by the Sub-Committee competent to approve it, the deposit shall be refunded.

9. If the amount of bid is not deposited the materials will be resold in any manner which the Managing Director thinks fit and in the event of its fetching a lesser price the difference should be made good by the original bidder.

10. The Managing Director reserves the right of altering of or adding to the above conditions, such other conditions as may be announced at the time of auction.

11. The materials will be open to inspection of bona fide bidders at the office of the Managing Director, Nellore Coop. Spinning mills, Nellore between 11-00 a.m. to 5-00 p.m. on any working day.

12. The Officer supervising the auction reserves the right of withdrawing the materials from the auction, if necessary without assigning any reasons.

13. If any dispute arises to any bid the materials may be put to auction again at the discretion of the Supervising Officer.

14. No complaint as to the quality of the materials will be entertained from the buyer after the materials have been auctioned.

15. Sales Tax and other local taxes if any shall be exclusive of the bid amount.

16. In the event of failure on the part of successful bidder to comply with condition 8 above, the sale shall stand cancelled and a resale held and the earnest money deposit and other amounts if any, already paid will be forfeited. It shall not incumbent upon the selling officer to give notice of such cancellation or resale to the defaulting bidder resale under this condition shall be at the risk of defaulting bidder who will not have claim to the profit if any, on account of such resale, and who in the event of loss, will be required to make good the difference between total amount payable by him and the total amount payable by the successful bidder at the resale.
